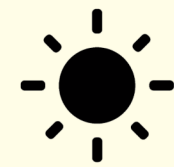


Peer Support Services Update - May 10, 2024



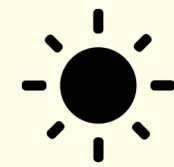
CRPS helps to ensure client directed care by assisting people to build the skills and relationships needed to achieve and maintain recovery from substance use and/or mental health conditions.



103 peers have been trained between October 2, 2023 and May 2, 2024.



48 of the peers have been trained in Helping Others Heal, the 40 hour required training for Peer Support Specialists.



45 of the peers have been trained in WRAP (Wellness Recovery Action Plan) Training, a 16-hour course that goes toward their CRPS certification.



We have trained peers in our substance use community, human trafficking community, and mental health community.
